**Introduction**

- In the two previous messages Moses offers some resistance, and in our passage today he raises another three objections.
- What is keeping Moses from zealously embracing the call to be Israel's heroic deliverer?

**Main Points: Three barriers to answering the call:**

1. **Conscience - I'm not \_\_\_\_\_ enough.**
  - Seeing isn't always \_\_\_\_\_; some things have to be believed to be seen.
    - Gideon - *Judges 6*
    - Paul - *Acts 9*
    - *1Kings 17.24*
    - The miracles are validation for Jesus' authority and they will validate Moses too.
  
2. **Confidence - I'm not \_\_\_\_\_ enough.**
  - God establishes his \_\_\_\_\_ at work in:
    - *Jeremiah 14.10*
    - *Ephesians 1.18-21*
    - *Hebrews 13.20-21*
    - *Proverbs 3.5-6*

3. **Courage – I'm not \_\_\_\_\_ enough.**

- God's name, God's word, and God's presence is all we need – we are \_\_\_\_\_ alone --
  - God meets personally with people
  - The Tabernacle, The Temple, The Incarnation...
  - The Holy Spirit
    - *1Corinthians 3.16*
    - *Romans 8.9 – 11*
