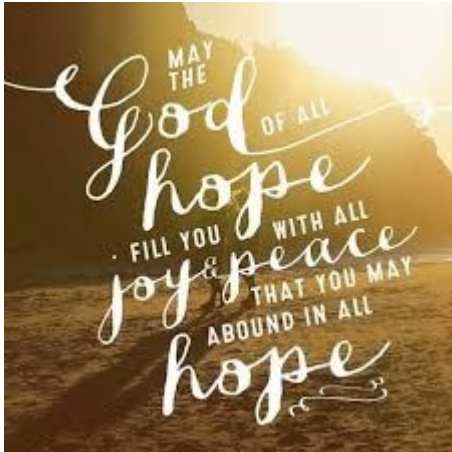

Dennis and Nancy Palmer, NAB Missionaries, Cameroon.



Dennis and Nancy Palmer have been working at Mbingo Baptist Hospital in northern Cameroon for the past fifteen years, having previously served for nearly a decade at Bansa Baptist Hospital and in other capacities. They currently work in hospital development, which includes a number of larger projects, including a long-term project to develop radiation therapy for cancer patients, a hydro-electric dam, and, more recently, a telepathology system. Pray for the Palmers as they move into a season of medical missions recruitment within the NAB. Pray as well for the safety of the doctors, staff, and patients at Mbingo, which is currently the only major hospital operating in the area due to the ongoing unrest.
