Explanation of the Text

- the sun and the moon stood still various theories:
 - it's literal -- the sun and moon simply stayed where they were in the sky until the battle ended and light was no longer necessary.
 - \circ a solar eclipse.
 - \circ $\;$ It is a metaphor. for a bad omen
 - The words are poetical.
 - A miracle of refraction of the sun's rays made it seem as if the sun and moon were out of their regular places.
 - There are two unverified claims that might have bearing here. First, some writings about this miracle report that there are Egyptian, Chinese, and Hindu records of a long day. Second, there are unconfirmed reports that "it is common knowledge among astronomers that one full day is missing in our astronomical calculations and that Professor Pickering of the Harvard observatory has traced it back to the time of Joshua."
 - Joshua did not ask for a longer day but rather for a release from the day's great heat. The Hebrew verb dom, which most of the English versions translate as "stand still," usually means "be silent, cease, or leave off."
