Taylor is rooted in a number of "Christian training institutes" that were widely dispersed across the western prairies. These institutes appealed to the many rural young people who were idle during the long prairie winters and provided trained lay leadership for the local churches, as well as opportunities for young people to utilize their time wisely. The school began with the financial support of and volunteer labour from many individuals within the Northern Conference Churches. Dr. and Mrs. E. P.
