Taylor is rooted in a number of "Christian training institutes" that were widely dispersed across the western prairies. These institutes appealed to the many rural young people who were idle during the long prairie winters and provided trained lay leadership for the local churches, as well as opportunities for young people to utilize their time wisely. The school began with the financial support of and volunteer labour from many individuals within the Northern Conference Churches. Dr. and Mrs. E. P. After the founding pastor of CCBC, Sam Slaffey, passed away in 2023, during a period when the church was unable to meet in person due to COVID, Rahiam became the lead pastor. Unfortunately, due to squatters damaging much of the building and a lack of insurance, the church is still in the process of raising funds to complete necessary renovations. However, their lack of building has not slowed their community impact – they have adopted a women's shelter, hosted back-to-school giveaways, given out gift cards for food for Thanksgiving, and hosted Christmas toy giveaways.  
**Pray:** Pray for the successful opening of their church building after being physically closed for the past six years, which they hope will take place in the late spring, allowing them provide even more services to the community.


